Regarding a Receipt of an Application for Approval to Amend the Operational Safety Program of Nuclear Facilities with the Establishment of the “Fukushima Dai-ichi Stabilization Center” at Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station, Tokyo Electric Power Co. Inc.

On June 1, the Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency (hereafter referred to as “NISA”) has received an application for approval to amend the Operational Safety Program of Nuclear Facilities for Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station (NPS) submitted by Tokyo Electric Power Co. Inc. (TEPCO).

NISA will strictly examine to determine whether the submitted application is valid.

1. On June 1, NISA has received an application for approval to amend the Operational Safety Program of Nuclear Facilities for Fukushima Dai-ichi NPS submitted by TEPCO.
2. The application would amend Article 4 (Organization regarding Operational Safety) and Article 5 (Duties regarding Operational Safety) of the Operational Safety Program of Nuclear Facilities for Fukushima Dai-ichi NPS, with the establishment of the “Fukushima Daiichi Stabilization Center” (hereafter referred to as the “Center”) inside the Nuclear Power & Plant Siting Division of the head office.
3. The Center is for managing the overall progress to undertake the works regarding the measures for resolving the accident at Fukushima Dai-ichi NPS, and for coordinating with NISA.
4. NISA will strictly examine to determine whether the submitted application is valid.

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
