Regarding Investigation of Existence of Errors in Reports
on Emergency Safety Measures (Direction)

The Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency (NISA) received a report today, stating that there were some errors in the reports submitted based on the direction “Regarding Implementation of Emergency Safety Measures for Other Power Stations Considering the Accident of Fukushima Dai-ichi and Dai-ni Nuclear Power Stations in 2011” dated March 30, 2011 (03.23.2011 NA No.7), the direction “Regarding Reliability Assurance of External Power Supply to Nuclear Power Stations and Reprocessing Facilities” dated April 15, 2011 (04.15.2011 NA No.3), the direction “Regarding Implementation of Preparatory Measures for Severe Accidents in Other NPSs Taking into Account the 2011 Accident at Fukushima Dai-ichi NPS” dated June 7, 2011 (06.07.2011 NA No.2), and the direction “Regarding the Seismic Measures for Switching Yard related to Securing Reliability of External Power Supply for Nuclear Power Stations, etc.” of the same date (06.07.2011 NA No.1) (hereinafter referred to as “the directions”) from Tohoku Electric Power Co., Inc., Chubu Electric Power Co., Inc., Kansai Electric Power Co., Inc., Chugoku Electric Power Co., Inc., Shikoku Electric Power Co., Inc., and Japan Atomic Power Co. (hereinafter referred to as “the operators”).

According to the report, although these errors were caused by misreading dimensions from the drawings, they are unlikely to affect the assessment results and the measures taken by the operators based on the directions.

However, NISA, taking into account the errors occurred in the reports from several operators, has decided to instruct the nuclear operators as per attached sheet, who submitted reports according to the directions, to investigate the possible existence of errors in their reports submitted to NISA prepared based on the directions, and if errors are identified, to clarify the cause of errors and to establish recurrence prevention measures, and to submit reports to NISA on the investigation results by September 28, 2011.
