Regarding the Notification of Disclosure of the Emergency Operating Procedures for Unit 1 at Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station, Tokyo Electric Power Co., Inc.

This is to inform the public that, today (October 14), the Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency (NISA) has decided to disclose part of the emergency operating procedure for Unit 1 of Fukushima Dai-ichi Nuclear Power Station (NPS), which was received from TEPCO, and has notified TEPCO accordingly.

1. On September 27, NISA ordered TEPCO to submit a report on the emergency operating procedures for Units 1, 2 and 3 of Fukushima Dai-ichi NPS pursuant to the Nuclear Regulation Act, and received the report on the procedures on September 27 and 28, 2011 (already notified on September 27 and 28).
2. NISA notified TEPCO on October 14 that, after having reviewed, NISA has decided to disclose part of the emergency operating procedures for Unit 1.

As to the part other than that will be disclosed this time, NISA is now preparing for the future disclosure of it, and will notify at an appropriate opportunity.
